- Complete beginning of year appointments with teachers. Verify that teachers completed selfreflection in Talent Ed when you meet, review goals and action plan, supports needed.

Suggested Oct Staff Meeting: Teachers share established SMART goals with each other (gallery walk) & baseline data. Make it public!

About Nov 30-1st Formal Obs per teacher if needed

Suggested Actions -- October Through December
