Our efforts include:


- We are working to implement the Common Core State Standards, which are rigorous and relevant and will better prepare students for college and careers.



### **OVERALL STATE RATING** HOW ARE STUDENTS AT THIS SCHOOL PERFORMING COMPARED TO THOSE AT OTHER SCHOOLS?

The overall state rating is intended to summarize this school's particular successes and challenges. It is based on a combination of up to five factors. Three of these factors come from standardized test scores in reading and math: student achievement, student growth, and the growth of underserved subgroups.
