



Dear Parent,

On \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ am/pm your student \_\_\_\_\_ experienced an injury to the head. Most head injuries are minor and do not require medical attention. However, a responsible adult should monitor your child for the next 24 hours.

If any of the following symptoms are observed, please contact a Health Care Provider immediately. For severe symptoms, call 911.

- Behavior changes (repetitive, slurred speech, clumsy, sluggish, forgetfulness)
- Seizure (convulsions)
- Unconsciousness
- Severe headache or neck pain
- Vomiting
- Vision changes
- Confusion

If a Health Care Provider diagnoses a concussion or recommends activity restrictions, PLEASE notify the school office immediately.
