

## Hand Truck Safety Tips



- Use the hand truck for only safe, reasonable sized loads. If necessary, make two trips.
- Maintain a low center of gravity. Stack heavier objects first.
- Check your load before moving. See that your load will not tip or shift.
- Do not walk backwards while moving the truck.
- Keep your back straight and use your leg muscles.
- Some volatile items, such as gas cylinders, must be strapped securely to the truck.
- Move only at safe speeds. Hasty turns could make you lose control and your load.
