- 3. For contract purposes the cost breakdown to the per site level can be done at a pre-determined cost instead of tracking as the work is performed. Billing of work should be done in the same manner.
- 4. One proposer asked about the make-up water usage for each building. That information is attached, but is only representative of a single month. Explanations for above average use are explained.
