An Online Program With Some Flexibility

- In the 21-22 school year Eugene Online Academy High School is *Asynchronous*- You can create the routine that works best for your child.
- It is possible that in the 22-23 school year Eugene Online Academy High School will incorporate some required check-ins or classes during the week. This is still TBD.



Teaching and Facilitating at EOA High School

- Students at EOA High School take 5 classes and typically spend a little over an hour in each class each day. (It is possible to take more than 5 should more credit be needed to graduate on time).
- Core subject teachers and program support staff are 4J staff with experience teaching in 4J. These classes receive more direct support (easier to schedule Zoom help meetings and weekly “To Do” posts).
- Elective classes are largely facilitated by an Oregon licensed teacher who 4J contracts to provide feedback and assistance to students. These classes receive less support (support via email and no weekly “To Do” posts).



Teaching and Facilitating at EOA High School

- While teachers at EOA Middle School do not provide live instruction, they are available to help students and parents when help is needed. Their day is largely dedicated to support and arranging a time for help is pretty easy.
- Teachers use youcanbook.me to make it easy for students to schedule a time for help.

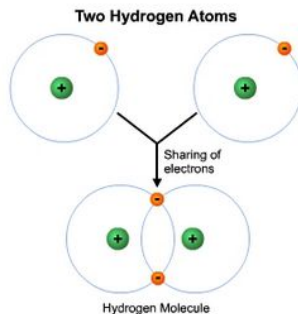

Molecule Formation

Two or more atoms join together through bonds. Chemical bonds form when atoms share or exchange electrons, allowing each atom to have a complete valence shell. In sharing electrons between two atoms, a [covalent](#) bond is formed. When chemical bonding of two or more atoms occurs, a [molecule](#) is formed.

Observe the hydrogen molecule, H_2 , shown here. Each hydrogen atom has a single electron, and its outer shell can hold a maximum of two electrons. By forming a bond, the two atoms share electrons. Both atoms end up with full outer shells. In this example, there is only one shell of electrons for each atom of hydrogen.

Special Education and ELD Supports at EOA Middle School

College Admissions Considerations

- In 2021-2022, EOA credits are awarded from the student's brick and mortar high school.
- Eugene Online Academy High School Courses are not listed with NCAA. This could impact college athletics.
- Courses have a FE designation in front of them (FuelEd). Ex: FE Algebra 1A
 - There has not been an issue that we are aware of with college admissions, but we do not want this to be a surprise.
