Two Options To Choose

- Eugene Online Academy is Asynchronous- You can create the routine that works best for your child.
- K-5 Connect is Synchronous- The program provides live Zoom instruction on a school schedule.
- In both programs students work each school day to learn and grow.



Teaching and Facilitating at EOA Elementary and K-5 Connect

- All staff (teaching and support) at both elementary programs are 4J employees. All of them have experience teaching and supporting students in the district.



Teaching and Facilitating at EOA Elementary

- EOA Elementary (Asynchronous) staff provide weekly assignment lists and guidance to parents on the last school day of the week. Having these guides before the weekend allows parents to determine when their students will work on assignments
- Students typically spend 6 hours a day “doing school” This would include some time for lunch and breaks.
- EOA Elementary is designed to be digital. There are no hard copies of materials provided.



Teaching and Facilitating at EOA Elementary

- While teachers at EOA Elementary do not provide live instruction, they are available to help students and parents when help is needed. Their day is largely dedicated to support and arranging a time for help is pretty easy.
- Teachers do provide (2) live sessions a day that are for social and emotional learning and connecting with classmates. The PM session repeats the AM session so there is flexibility for families.



Teaching and Facilitating at EOA Elementary

- The curriculum at Eugene Online Academy is provided by FLVS (Florida Virtual School). We license a version that is aligned to national standards.
- Students have access to math, science, social studies, language arts, PE, art, and technology classes

Special Education and ELD Supports at EOA Elementary

- Special Education and ELD teachers support students at EOA by providing live small group or 1:1 instruction. Attendance at these live groups is an aspect of EOA Elementary that is required in order to provide students with their supports.
- These teachers work with families to try to create a schedule that works. They have been successful in doing that thus far.
- EOA Elementary is not a title program.



Teaching and Facilitating at K-5 Connect

- The staff at EOA Elementary provide live Zoom instruction on a schedule very similar to an in-person school day

Teaching and Facilitating at K-5 Connect

- The curriculum at K-5 Connect is the same curriculum that is used in 4J's elementary schools.
- However, each school in the district is slightly different, so in the same vein, K-5 Connect teachers will also have some different materials that they may use in class.
- Each semester K-5 Connect holds a materials distribution to get printed materials and other materials to students.



Special Education and ELD Supports at K-5 Connect

- Special Education and ELD teachers support students at EOA by providing live small group instruction.
- This instruction is done by pulling students into small groups during the school day.
- K-5 Connect is not a Title program.
