An Online Program With Some Flexibility

- In the 21-22 school year Eugene Online Academy Middle School is Asynchronous- You can create the routine that works best for your child.
- It is likely that in the 22-23 school year Eugene Online Academy Middle School will incorporate some required check-ins or classes during the week. This is still TBD.

Teaching and Facilitating at EOA Middle School

- Students at EOA Middle School take 5 classes and typically spend a little over an hour in each class each day. One term has PE, another has health, and another is for an elective.
- Core subject teachers and program support staff are 4J staff with experience teaching in 4J.
 These classes receive more direct support (easier to schedule Zoom help meetings and weekly "To Do" posts.
- Elective classes are largely facilitated by an Oregon licensed teacher who 4J contracts to provide feedback and assistance to students. These classes receive less support (support via email and no weekly "To Do" posts.

Teaching and Facilitating at EOA Middle School

- While teachers at EOA Middle School do not provide live instruction, they are available to help students and parents when help is needed. Their day is largely dedicated to support and arranging a time for help is pretty easy.
- Teachers use youcanbook.me to make it easy for students to schedule a time for help.


