The El Monte Union High School District requires a yearly physical for students participating in co-curricular and extracurricular activities. All physicals will expire 1 year from the initial date of physical. Physical Expiration emails will be sent to the email on file at 30 days, and again at 10 days. Once submitted and approved, your physical will be valid for 1 calendar year from your initial physical date. EMUHSD and CIF-SS require all sports physical exams to be completed by a qualified medical provider. Qualified exams, signatures and documentation are acceptable from the following: Medical Doctor, Doctor of Osteopathic, Nurse Practitioner, or Physician's Assistant, (MD, DO, NP, PA).
