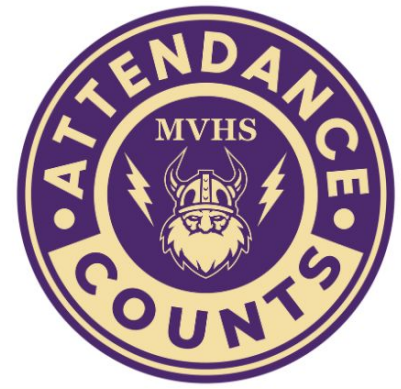


EMUHSD LATE TO SCHOOL FOOD POLICY
