8. "Those who die with us die in peace. For me, that is the greatest development of human life, to die in peace and in dignity, for that is eternity (Chawla 172). Mother Teresa said this quote directly to the author of the story explaining to him that the real meaning of death was "going home". If a person ended their life peacefully, they would remain peaceful for the rest of time.

"I prefer you to make a mistake in kindness than to work miracles in unkindness; and try never to refuse anyone who is sick" (Chawla 164). Mother Teresa said this quote to her Sisters. Her message is that the only right way to do things is through kindness and from your heart. Without this, there will be no truth in the good deeds you do.

"To understand the poor, you must stand under the poor" (Chawla 141). The meaning of this quote is simply that you must experience one's hardships before you can fully understand what they are going through. Only a poor person can understand the pain of another poor person.
