- Technical School/professional trade license
- Work
- Military
- Gap/interim year

What to consider?

- Financial needs, fit and outcome
- Many great programs affordable Certificate, Associate's, Bachelor's and Master's degree programs – all within the MA State College system!

What should I be doing THIS year?

Keep up your grades this year! Get extra help, keep up with work!

Research and VISIT options (colleges, programs, etc.)

Teacher recommendations - some colleges will require 1-2 recommendations; you should speak with teachers about this junior spring

Meet with your school counselor - If you need a recommendation you will need to complete the "Student Interview Packet" and then meet with your counselor to discuss

If you are thinking of applying to a school Early Action or Early Decision, you should ask for letters of recommendation between April – June of junior year.

What should I be doing THIS year?

SAT & ACT

We recommend taking either at least 1 time your junior spring, and 1 time your senior fall.

<u>TOEFL</u>


- •May be recommended for some students who learned a first language other than English.

Transcript & GPA


- A transcript is a list of your final grades and credits received for each class that you've taken at Framingham High School. As a junior, it includes your weighted GPA from Grades 9 and 10.
- A transcript <u>does not</u> include:
 - Quarter grades or exam grades
 - Attendance
 - Discipline
 - Standardized Test Scores



Scattergrams


- → Scattergrams show to which colleges and universities former FHS students have applied.

How to View Scattergrams


Type the college you want to learn about




1) Click on the school Framingham State



2) Click "Admissions"




3) Scroll down!




Scattergram for Framingham State

- = You (based on your GPA and ACT/SAT scores)






