Complete the Senior Survey ASAP!

1. Go to Naviance: <https://student.naviance.com/auth/fclookup>
2. Search "Framingham High School" and click "Go" then select our school (zip code is 01701)
3. Click "Student"
4. Use your Framingham Email Address to log into Naviance
5. Once you are logged in, on the top right click "About Me" and then "Surveys from Your School"
6. Click on "**Senior Survey: Class of 2022**"



****Important Note:** if you are attending a 2 or 4 year college, make sure to select which school you will be attending.

This is a reminder that after graduation, your @fpsed.org (FHS) email will be dissolving.

Submitting AP Exam Scores

AP Exams are submitted through your [College Board](#) account.

Only the school you've committed to needs your official AP scores. AP Score Reports sent via the College Board have a standard submission fee of \$15 p/exam. Students should check



with their respective college's Admissions Department to see the minimum score send (e.g. 3, 4 or 5) and if the college will accept credit for their AP exam(s).

Important information for students attending Mass Bay CC this fall



Directions / to-do for students attending Mass Bay this fall (June-August):

1. Complete the **senior survey** so that your school counselor knows to send your final transcript to Mass Bay. To do this you will:
Log-in to [Naviance](#) --> click 'about me' in top right corner --> click 'my surveys' on drop down --> click Class of 2022 survey and complete
2. Take an **Accuplacer** exam (placement test for math and English); this virtual test will place you in a math and English course at Mass Bay (it is not pass/fail). You can [sign-up here](#).
3. Register for a fall **Orientation** slot (via your Mass Bay SOAR account). Here are the dates you can take an orientation.
