## HOW TO TRANSLATE / TRADUCIR / TRADUZIR

- **English**: On a computer/laptop, click "Translate" in the black box. On a mobile phone/tablet click the Accessibility Icon at the bottom of your phone screen and then click 'translate'.
- **Español**: Desde una computadora o portátil (laptop), haga clic en "Translate" en el cuadro negro. Desde un teléfono celular o tableta, haga clic en el icono "Accessibility" en la parte inferior de la pantalla y luego haga clic en "Translate".

#### **DECISION DAY IS ON MAY 1st!**

May 1st is National Decision Day in the United States, which means it's time for four-year college bound seniors to make a final decision about which college/university they'll be attending.



Once students decide on the college or university they plan to attend, they will need to put down a certain amount of money, known as an **ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT** to confirm their acceptance. This deposit is applied to tuition for the first year. \*Deposits are non-refundable.\* Deposits should be put down on or before May 1st through the college/university's portal.

**Applicants must** <u>commit to a college</u> by May 1. Once you receive an offer letter, you can respond at any point before that date to secure your spot.

- National College Decision Day traditionally lands on the first day of May each year.
- Decision Day is when first-year applicants commit to a college.
- Be sure to prepare for Decision Day to avoid problems.

The senior survey is a MANDATORY requirement for all Class of 2023 students, & it must be completed by Friday, May 12, 2023!

Question #7 is where you write the college or university you are attending, if applicable. Colleges require a final transcript and this is how we will know where to send yours! If you have not made a final decision, you may wait to submit the survey until you do so.

## Transitioning out of your FPSED Email

Go to  $\underline{\text{takeout.google.com}} \rightarrow \text{This service}$  will help you to transfer your files and other content to another personal Google account or will prepare it to be saved as a downloadable file. Follow the Takeout instructions to determine which of the services you want to transfer



data from. (We would recommend, at minimum, your Contacts, Drive content, and Mail.)

- Your Google Drive storage space will remain available over this summer. It will officially expire on December 31st, 2023.
- Please email <a href="mailto:helpdesk@framingham.k12.ma.us">helpdesk@framingham.k12.ma.us</a> if you are having difficulties with this or if you can no longer access your account.

Forward your @fpsed.org email to another address: You will likely not be using your @fps.org email daily after graduation. It's a good idea to set up email forwarding for that address to an email address that you'll be using more frequently. You can follow these instructions, created by Google, to automatically forward your school email to a personal email account, so that you don't miss any important information in the next 6 months.


## The Common Application

The **COLLEGE APPLICATION** is the backbone of all of the information a college/university needs to know about you to assess if you'd be a good fit for their school. The majority of schools use the **Common Application** as their application portal. Some schools have an application portal built into their website, and other schools use an application portal called the **Coalition App** (similar to the Common App; see schools that use the Coalition App here). Creating an account on any of these portals is free,



but most colleges/universities have a cost associated with applying. All applications are created and submitted online.

## Transcript Requests & Letters of Recommendation

Seniors applying to four-year colleges will most likely need one to two teacher letters of recommendation. However, they will need to find out the exact number required by checking the "application requirements" on the websites of the colleges to which they are applying. To request a teacher letter of recommendation, please follow the steps listed on the <a href="Teacher Recommendation">Teacher Recommendation</a> Letter Guide. You should always plan to give your teachers a minimum of 15 school days notice prior to your first application deadline.

## Transcript Request Form instructions

## Counselor Letter of Recommendation

Seniors applying to four-year colleges will most likely need a counselor letter of recommendation. However, they will find out for sure by checking the "application requirements" on the websites of the colleges to which they are applying.

### Teacher Letter(s) of Recommendation

4-year college apps likely need 1-2 teacher LOR (check LOR requirements on the website of each college). Plan to give your teachers a minimum of 15 school days notice prior to your first application deadline.





Nerdy Girl Success is hosting a free event, specifically tailored for young women in high school - it is our Career and Leadership Summit for High School Girls!


