	Begin to use Naviance to explore career and college possibilities!
JU	NIOR YEAR: January - March
	Continue to focus on your academics. We *emphasize* this because colleges look carefully at junior year final grades!
\bigcap	Continue thinking about what you would like to do after high school! If you are interested
_	in attending college, research, research! This includes using
	online resources AND visiting schools (if you can)!
	Think about taking a FREE SAT and/or ACT practice test, hosted by FHS and various
	test prep companies. This gives you information about if the ACT or SAT is a better fit for
	you!
	It is recommended to take the ACT or the SAT at least ONCE your junior spring
	and once your senior fall.
	→ Decide when you are going to take them and register at www.collegeboard.org or
	www.actstudent.org.
	→ Reach out to Ms. Erikson (E118) in the College & Career Center (CACC) or your school
	counselor if you have any questions about registering for the SAT/ACT or fee waivers.
JU	NIOR YEAR: April - June
\bigcap	Make an appointment with your school counselor to talk about your plans for after high
_	school. If you are applying to a four-year college, you will need to fill out a
_	Student Interview Packet <i>before</i> meeting with you counselor.
	Decide which teacher(s) you would like to ask to write you a recommendation if
	you will need one or two for college applications and then ask (in-person)!
	Continue to research different options (career, college, etc.) and talk to people about their
_	experiences after high school! Naviance is your friend 😊
