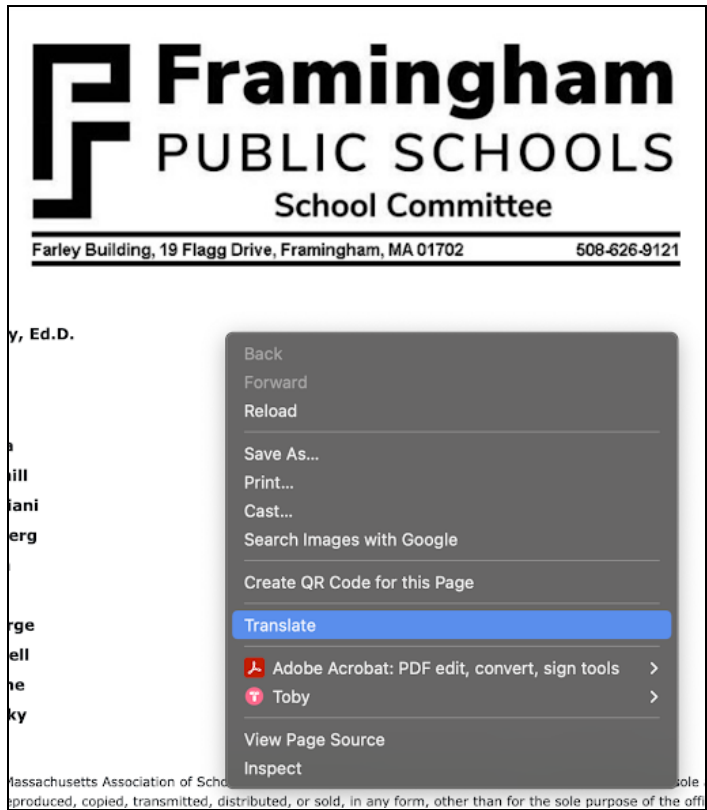
How to Translate Framingham Policies Using Google Chrome

1. Go to the online platform using Google Chrome

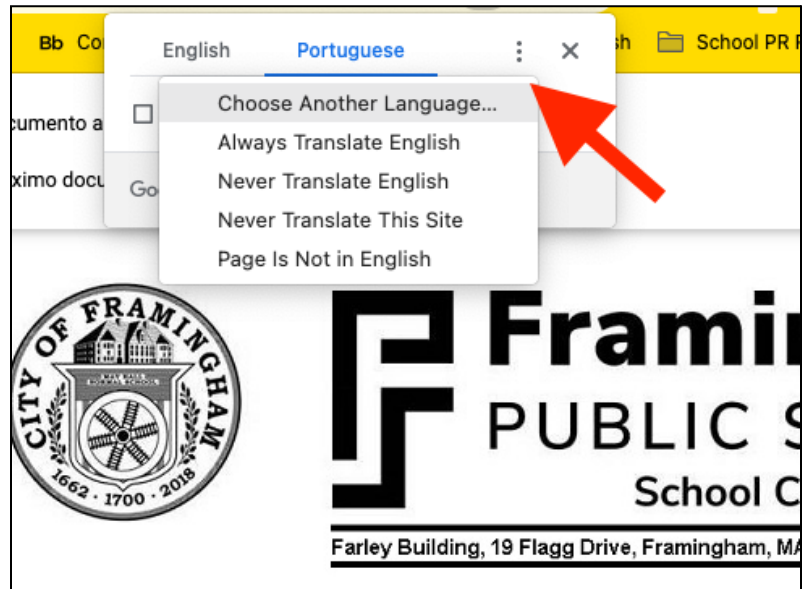

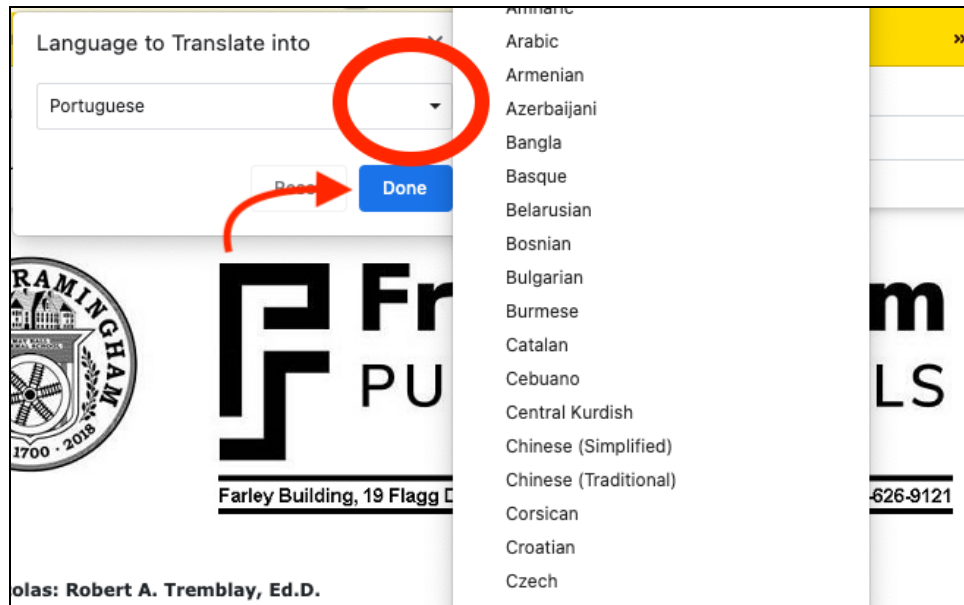
2. Right click anywhere on the screen and choose "Translate". This may automatically be set to English or another language. You can change the language in the next step.



3. After you click 'Translate...', click the three buttons next to English or whichever language first appears, and select "Choose Another Language".



4. Select your preferred language from the dropdown menu and click "Done".



The website and any policy you select will now be translated to your preferred language.
