- The Smart Schools Bond Act was passed in a statewide referendum on November 4, 2014
- Allocated \$2 Billion to NYS school districts for the purpose of improved learning and opportunity through the funding of educational technology and infrastructure improvements.

#### OVERVIEW OF SSBA

- ▶ The Fulton City School District was allocated \$3,971,619.00
- This funding can be used for:
  - ➤ Technology infrastructure like wiring, switch equipment, wireless access technology and equipment, firewalling equipment
  - Devices for instructional use, for example computers, laptops, tablets, interactive boards, projectors
  - Facilities improvements
