

Student Parking

Parking privileges and assigned spaces will be allocated to seniors/juniors in good standing. Students should be aware of the following:

Parking at the school lot is a privilege. Reasons to lose that privilege include:

- Unsafe driving in the parking lot
- Being on the ineligibility list
- Serious disciplinary issue(s)
- Parking lot abuse (parking in a spot other than the one designated, parking in an inconsiderate manner)
- Tardiness to school (**arriving after 8:05**)
After 3 tardies, privilege may be suspended for up to one week
After 6 tardies, privilege may be suspended for up to one month
After 9 tardies, privilege may be revoked for the remainder of the school year
- Driving or riding with another student to the Career Ed Center

Note: Bus transportation is available; therefore, car trouble does not constitute a legal tardy.
