

Graduation Rate




We can't teach them if they are not here!


- Chronic Absenteeism is defined by a student missing 10% or more of the days they are enrolled in school.
- Excused or unexcused does not matter
- Examples:
 - For full year (180 days) students missing 18 or more days are deemed chronically absent.
 - For half of a year, 90 days, students missing 9 or more days are deemed chronically absent.
- P-6 & 7-12 Attendance Committees created in 2018-19
 - Ensure Accurate Data
 - Training and Policy/Procedure reviews
 - Action Plans / Gap Closing Goals
- In 2017-2018, GCSD had 12% of its students chronically absent.
- In 2018-2019, GCSD had 8% of its students chronically absent.

Percentage of Students Passing Regents Exams





Student Proficiency on NYS 3-8 ELA & Math Assessments






Students who took the NYS 3-8 ELA & Math Assessments



Architect's rendering of the GCSD auditorium and music addition.


Capital Project Update

- Construction begins September 2019

- Construction Project consists of:
 - New: Auditorium, Band/Chorus Room, Set Design Room, PA System with additional speakers, ELPE Office/Storage, Bathroom with playground access, OT/PT classroom
 - Renovate: Baseball & Softball Fields, Air Quality/Ventilation 2nd Floor, elementary music room
 - <u>Security:</u> Security Vestibule, Building Access System, Outdoor lighting
