Thanks to a local GSEF grant, Germantown is excited to host The Shakespeare Theatre of New Jersey's Shakespeare LIVE! education tour and workshop on 3/27. During the FLEX period that immediately follows the performance, students will be invited to attend "Speak the Speech" workshops where performers will guide students through analysis and performance of different Shakespeare texts.
