Purchase Proposal

The goal of these purchases is to continue to replace both aging student-use devices and laptops used by teachers for remote and in-person instruction. Aging Lenovo laptops still in use continue to break down, cannot handle the requirements of our software, and are not reliable enough to comply with NYS testing requirements.

The overall impact of these purchases will benefit our students and staff by creating an educational environment geared toward success. These improvements are intended to enhance engagement and enthusiasm among students, improve teacher-student relationships, and promote 21st-century skills such as technological proficiency, collaboration, and problem solving. These devices will also support remote instruction in instances where it may still be necessary due to COVID19.
