



SUPPLY LIST

- **1 flip top reusable water bottle** (less spills with flip top)
- **1 composition book**
- **6 glue sticks** (we will need replenishing throughout the year; they go fast!)
- **2 packs of crayons** (16 count preferred; 24 count max)
- **1 yellow highlighter**
- **2 thin BLACK dry erase markers**
- **1 large eraser** (no eraser caps please)
- **1 plastic pencil/supply box** (for our desks; snap shut; NOT zippered please)
- **1 pair of scissors** (blunt tip)
- **2 sturdy folders** (at least one folder should be durable and plastic) NO TRAPPER KEEPER FOLDERS please. Students cannot easily file papers in those.
- **1 box of tissues**
- **Headphones:** These are used often for: listening to stories on the iPad, reading and math testing, listening to music, and occasionally to block out sound to aid in concentration. Earbuds don't seem to work well in the First Grade classroom.
