In order to have a fun year, our most important goal is to create a family of learners. We read, write, spell, work on math, science and social studies topics. We emphasize character strengths through our Positivity Project. We enjoy art, music, physical education, computer, and library. First grade is the best!

We have the pleasure of having your child in our First Grade class this year. We will be working on reading, writing, math, science, and more! First Grade is such an important year. This year will look a little different from Kindergarten. We're excited to tell you all about it!



To help our students learn, practice, and master first grade skills, this class will be co-taught. Coteaching is when two certified teachers are present in the classroom and they work together through the teaching process: planning, teaching, and assessing progress. Students frequently have different learning styles and preferences. Coteaching often allows those different needs to be more easily met. We both bring our specialties to the classroom: Mrs. Delamater brings 25 years of grade level and reading experience and Ms. Newman brings a decade of experience in Special Education and Therapeutic Crisis intervention.



Having two teachers in the same classroom looks different depending on the activity we're doing in class and the needs of the students.

- ★ Sometimes we like to split the class into two groups with each teacher teaching one of the groups; this allows for a smaller teacher-to-student ratio for more complex topics.
- ★ Occasionally, one teacher will pull a small group aside for additionalsupport instruction while the other teacher assists students with an extension assignment. This way, students receive additional help when needed or they receive meaningful extension activities led by a teacher
- ★ The possibilities are endless!
