GUSD Goals for 2015 - 2016

By 2018 – 2019, GUSD students will be proficient in:

- Reading by the end of 3rd grade
- Math at the end of 6th grade
- Content-area <u>Literacy</u> by the end of 11th grade
- Math courses through <u>Algebra II</u> by the end of 11th grade
- Courses satisfying the <u>a-g (UC/CSU)</u> requirements and/or CTE Pathways by the end of 12th grade

GUSD Actions for 2015 - 2016

- 1. Implement the California Common Core State Standards in all curricular areas and at the secondary level deepen the understanding of the Next Generation Science Standards.
- 2. Assess all students in grades K-9 and 10-12 (as needed), using the i-Ready Universal Diagnostic to establish beginning of year baseline and mid-year data (except 90:10, K-2/FLAG).
- 3. Use research-based best practices in the development of lessons and instruction to ensure access to rigorous and relevant content for all students.
- 4. Provide targeted, data-driven interventions for students not yet proficient.
- 5. Demonstrate growth as a school site toward District Goals by the end of 2015-2016.
