

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Safety is our top priority during drop-off and pick-up at school. Please review the following page to help ensure the safety of all Fremont students.

When dropping off and picking up your child(ren), please remember to respect our neighbors, the neighborhood and traffic laws. Do not block or park in driveways, double park, or make U-turns in the middle of the street. Refrain from texting, talking on the phone or other activities that distract you from driving. Make sure to always use crosswalks for safety and also to set a good example to students.

Thank you in advance for working together as a community to keep our students safe and for following the directions of our crossing guard staff and volunteers.

## **DROP-OFF PROCEDURES**

Please have your child in school on time each morning. Arrive early to avoid traffic delays

- 1st-6th graders are to be in class line by 8:05 AM
- Kindergarteners are to be in class line by 7:55 AM

The Las Palmas Avenue front entrance gate and the on Paloma Avenue gates open at 7:30 AM, when supervision begins.

Kindergarteners entering school after 8:00 AM and 1st-6th graders entering after 8:10 AM should enter through the office and get a tardy slip. Gates will be locked promptly at 8:10 AM

Walkers may enter through both the Las Palmas Avenue and Paloma Avenue gates, however, the Las Palmas entrance is preferred to avoid pedestrian congestion at the drive-through.

Bikers (4th-6th grade only) must enter the Las Palmas gate and walk their bikes to the rack by the lunch benches. Bikes must be locked up. Helmets must be worn when bike riding.

Drivers should only drop-off via the Paloma Avenue drive-through (not Las Palmas). Please follow these practices:

- Drive slowly (under 5 mph) in coned lane
- Wait until you have passed through the cone area to exit, even if your child is already out of the car
- Students should be ready to exit when parents enter the drop-off area. Say goodbyes beforehand and have backpack in hand (not in trunk)
- Drivers should not get out of the car while in the drive-through lane.

If your child needs assistance getting out of the car (including being unbuckled), please find a parking spot and walk your child to the gate. School staff may not assist students with unbuckling seatbelts/car seats.

#### At the Drive-Through:

- Kindergarteners enter the mid-block Paloma Avenue gate and line up on the playground
- 1st-6th graders enter through the gate closest to the lunch benches, where they sit until 8:00 AM
- At 8:00 AM, 1st-6th graders are escorted to the playground where they sit in class line until the morning bell rings.
- 1st-6th graders entering between 8:00-8:05 AM may enter the playground from the mid-block gate, directly on the playground.

## PICK-UP PROCEDURES

Please pick-up your child(ren) on time. Kindergarteners are dismissed daily at 12:13 PM. 1st-3rd graders at 2:15 PM (Wednesdays at 1:15 PM) and 4th-6th graders at 2:35 PM (Wednesdays at 1:35 PM). Please make arrangements if you are unable to pick-up your child(ren) on time. The office staff is not responsible for student supervision.

All kindergarteners are to be picked up at the gate on Paloma, either by foot or by car.

1st-6th graders should know where they will be picked up before they get to school. Children picked up by foot should meet their parents at the Las Palmas gate (not on Paloma).

For Drive-Through Pick-Ups:

- Parents should make an easily visible sign with your child's first and last name and display it on your dash board
- If your child is not waiting for you when you arrive, please be prepared to circle the block.
- Drivers are not to exit their car while in the drivethrough lane.
