#### **GUSD Transitional Kindergarten Program**



- Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is the first year of a two-year Kindergarten program for children turning 5 years old on or between September 2 and December 2 of the upcoming school year.
- TK uses a modified Kindergarten curriculum that is age and developmentally appropriate.
- A child who participates in TK must complete the second year of the program in Kindergarten before attending first grade.
- TK is not available at all Elementary Schools. Contact the office of Student Support Services for enrollment information (818) 241-3111 ext. 1283.
- Enrollment packets for the 2018-2019 school year will be available at your neighborhood school (even if the school does not have TK) starting February 20, 2018.




