## DRAMA MANIACS "KID-CREATED" MUSICALS

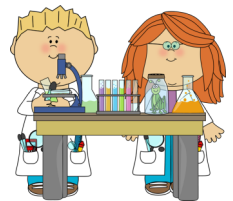
