

Inspired by the popular Broadway musical "Hamilton," the Musical Theatre Guild brings us the brand-new show "Revolution!"

In every age and every century, the world has been shaped by the acts of brave souls who have dared to think differently and defy the status quo. History has been formed by a series of revolutions, both large and small. "Revolution!" brings American history to musical life using examples from vibrant musical theatre. Electronic Flyer Delivery Starts February 6!

On February 6, GUSD will launch a new electronic flyer communication tool called "Peachjar." This "green" initiative will allow our parents to access flyers in three easy ways – online, by email, and in our GUSD app. All school and district flyers will be housed online in an "electronic backpack" where they can be filtered, sorted, and saved.

How will I receive flyers from my child's school?

You will be able to receive flyers in three different ways:

1. Email

On February 6, you will receive a welcome email from our service provider (Peachjar) that includes a username and password. This is provided to give you the opportunity to manage your account and flyer delivery preferences. You do not need to login to receive or view school digital flyers. Flyers will be automatically sent to your inbox. Don't want to receive flyers by email? You can unsubscribe at any time.

2. Online

Beginning February 6, to view school-approved Digital flyers, you will simply click the Peachjar button on your school's website homepage (under Site Shortcuts) to visit your online "electronic backpack."



3. GUSD App

Beginning February 6, you can follow "Peachjar" for your school in the GUSD app by selecting the Peachjar feed under the "Settings" icon (Settings -> Follow Schools -> Your School Name -> Peachjar). Then, just select the Peachjar icon in the app to view school-approved flyers in your "electronic backpack."

The Peachjar system is used exclusively for distribution of school-approved flyers. <u>Your email address will not be shared or used for any other purpose</u>. Thank you for supporting our efforts to ensure parents are well informed about school programs, activities, and events!



Գլենդելի հանրային դպրոցների կրթաշրջան

Թռուցիկների էլեկտրոնային ծանուցումը սկսվում է փետրվարի 6-ին

Փետրվարի 6-ին Գլենդելի հանրային դպրոցների կրթաշրջանը կսկսի նոր թռուցիկների Էլեկտրոնային հաղորդակցման գործիքը, որը կոչվում է «Peachjar»։ Այս «կանաչ» մտահաղացումը հնարավորություն կտա մեր ծնողներին թռուցիկներին ծանոթանալ երեք կերպ՝ առցանց, Էլեկտրոնային փոստի և GUSD-ի մեր ծրագրի միջոցով։ Քոլոր դպրոցների և կրթաշրջանի վերաբերյալ թռուցիկները հասանելի կլինեն առցանց՝ «Էլեկտրոնային պայուսակի ("electronic packpack")»-ի մեջ, որտեղ կարող են դրանք տարբերակվել, դասավորվել և պահվել։

Ինչպե՞ս եմ ստանալու թռուցիկներ երեխայիս դպրոցից

Դուք թռուցիկներ կստանաք երեք տարբեր ձևով՝

1. Էլեկտրոնային փոստ

Փետրվարի 6-ին, դուք ողջույնի էլեկտրոնային նամակ կստանաք մեր ծառայություն մատակարարողից (Peachjar), որը կպարունակի գործածողի անունը և գաղտնաբառը։ Այն տրվում է ձեզ, որպեսզի դուք հնարավորություն ունենաք այցելել ձեր բաժինը և կարգավորել թռուցիկները ստանալու տարբերակը։ Կարիք չունեք մուտք գործել, որպեսզի ստանաք կամ տեսնեք դպրոցի էլեկտրոնային թռուցիկները։ Դրանք միշտ կուղարկվեն ձեր նամակների մեջ։ Եթե չեք ցանկանում ստանալ թռուցիկները էլ. փոստի միջոցով, կարող եք դադարեցնել ձեր բաժանորդագրումը։

2. Արցանց

Фետրվարի 6-ից սկսած` կարող եք տեսնել դպրոցի էլեկտրոնային թռուցիկները, պարզապես սեղմելով Peachjar-ի վրա` ձեր դպրոցի կայք էջում (կայքի shortcut-երի մեջ), որպեսզի կարողանաք մուտք գործել ձեր առցանց «էլեկտրոնային պայուսակը»:



3. GUSD-ի ծրագիր

Փետրվարի 6-ից սկսած՝ GUSD-ի ծրագրի մեջ կարող եք հետևել Peachjar-ին՝ ընտրելով դա «Settings»-ի մեջից (Settings -> Follow Schools -> Your School Name -> Peachjar)։ Այնուհետև, ծրագրի մեջ ընտրեք Peachjar-ը, որպեսզի տեսնեք դպրոցի վերաբերյալ թռուցիկները ձեր «էլեկտրոնային պայուսակի» մեջ։

2월6일부터 전자 전단지 배달 시작!

글렌데일 통합교육구(GUSD)는 2월 6일에 "Peachjar"라 부르는 새로운 전자 전단지 통신 도구를 출시할 예정입니다. 이 "친환경"계획은 세 가지 간단한 방법 - 온라인, 이메일 및 우리 GUSD 앱으로 우리 학부모들이 전단지에 접근하도록 가능하게 할 것입니다. 모든 학교 및 교육구 전단지를 여과, 분류 및 저장할 수 있는 "전자 배낭 – electronic backpack"안에 온라인으로 보관될 것입니다.

2. 온라인

학교에서 승인된 전자 전단지를 보기 위해 2월 6일부터, 귀하는 학교 웹 사이트 홈페이지 (Site Shortcuts 밑)의 Peachjar 버튼을 클릭하면 귀하의 온라인 "전자 배낭"을 방문하게 됩니다.



3. **GUSD** 앱

2월 6일부터, 귀하는 GUSD 앱에서 "Settings" 아이콘 (Settings ---> Follow Schools ---> Your School Name ---> Peachjar) 밑에 Peachjar 을 선택해서 "Peachjar" 을 팔로우 할 수 있습니다. 그런 다음, 귀하의 "전자 배낭" 안에 학교가 승인한 전단지를 보기 위해 앱 안에 있는 Peachjar 아이콘을 선택합니다.

¡El 6 de febrero se inicia el envío electrónico de Volantes!

El 6 de febrero, el GUSD iniciará un nuevo medio de comunicación electrónico de volantes llamado "Peachjar." Esta iniciativa "verde" permitirá que los padres tengan acceso a los volantes de tres sencillas maneras – en línea, por correo electrónico y nuestra app del GUSD. Todos los volantes de la escuela y del distrito serán almacenados en internet en una "mochila electrónica" donde pueden ser filtrados, ordenados y guardados.

¿Cómo recibiré los volantes de la escuela de mi estudiante?

Recibirá los volantes de tres diferentes maneras:

1. Correo electrónico

El 6 de febrero, recibirá un correo electrónico de bienvenida de nuestro proveedor de servicio (Peachjar) que incluirá el nombre de usuario y la contraseña. Esto es provisto para darles la oportunidad de manejar su cuenta y sus preferencias para el envió de los volantes. Si no desea recibir los volantes por correo electrónico, pueden cancelar la suscripción en cualquier momento.

2. En línea

Comenzando el 6 de febrero, para ver los volantes Digitales aprobados por la escuela seleccione el botón Peachjar en la página web de su escuela (bajo Site Shortcuts) para visitar su "mochila electrónica" en línea.



3. El App del GUSD
