

- 1. Ask office front desk for key.
- Make a right past the second building (kindergarten building) towards the back where there is a small grass area and storage unit.
- 3. Within the larger unit is the smaller unit that requires the key. Open both units.
- 4. Put out Book & Game OPEN sign.
- 5. Open Umbrella for shade. (Be sure to secure umbrella with bungee cord when recess is over.)
- 6. Place yoga mats and blankets on the ground for kids to play.
- 7. Place some coloring books, blank paper and pencils on the table.
- 8. Encourage the kids; help them get games out/ in and assist when needed.


