A SPRINKLE IN TIME: WATER WASTE APP CREATED BY CLARK STUDENTS

A group of Clark students in the Environmental GIS class have developed an app using Esi software that allows users at GUSD schools to document and report water waste. From a mobile device, it is possible to upload a photo of the issue along with a description and precise GPS location. This can also be done from a Chromebook or desktop computer. Water Waste can be any broken water source, including leaks, sprinkler over spray, etc.
