- 1.2 Increase the district average scale score of students in grades 3-8 on the Mathematics portion of the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) Assessments 10 points from 2525 to 2535 by June 2018.
- 1.3 Increase English Learner Progress by 1% (THIS PERCENTAGE MAY BE TOO LOW) from 83% to 84% by June 2018.
- 1.4 Increase high school cohort graduation rate by 1% from 91.5% to 92.5% by June 2018.
