Action 6: Provide students with access to **technology** and **standards-aligned instructional materials**.

- Access to standards-aligned materials
- Access to technology in the classroom

Action 7: Provide a **positive environment** and **opportunities for students to connect** with their school and community.

- Attendance rates
- Chronic absenteeism rates
