

CVHS Incoming 9th Grade Registration

Frequently Asked Questions ????

- 1) **What is the due date and where do students submit registration information?**
Friday, February 24th. Students must complete the Google Form link AND add course requests to the student.gusd.net portal.
- 2) **How do I complete the Google form?**
PLEASE VIEW THE REGISTRATION POWERPOINT. Counselors will explain the process during the zoom presentation on Feb 8th. Complete each section by choosing the most appropriate class in each subject area. Include alternate elective options in case your first choice is full.
- 3) **How do I complete the online Q student portal course requests?**
There is a video explaining the step by step process for online registration on the CV website. Courses must be entered on the STUDENT portal, NOT the PARENT portal. If students have problems accessing the Student portal (student.gusd.net) they should contact the appropriate tech support person at Rosemont.
- 4) **Why do I need to submit the Google form AND register online?**
CV counselors will use the Google form as a back-up and to adjust any summer courses or alternates. Students who do not submit the forms or who do not complete the online course requests will be given last priority for classes.
- 5) **What if I do not have a 9th grade enrollment link in my student portal? (usually Permit students)**
If you do not have a 2023-24 future enrollment for CVHS, please check your enrollment status and future school with your school office. Write a note in the comments sections of the Google registration form indicating the student portal link was not active and submit the form. The CV counselors will adjust the records if/when your CV enrollment is activated. Most students on a permit will not have a future enrollment at this time. Permits are processed by the CVHS Attendance Office or the GUSD Student Services office.
- 6) **Can I make changes after I submit the forms?**
Yes. If you change your mind or need to make a change, you can adjust your requests during the 1-1 student counselor meetings after spring break. CV Counselors will meet with Rosemont students between April 6th-11th during Rosemont History classes. If you need to make additional changes AFTER meeting with the counselor, please email your CVHS counselor BEFORE May 19th, 2023. NO CHANGES will be made after May 19th unless a summer course completion or sports roster impacts the schedule requested.
- 7) **Do I need to submit a 4 year plan?**
No. The 4 YEAR PLAN helps provide as an overview of your high school experience. Plans are flexible and changeable every year. We will not be reviewing individual incoming 9th grade plans with students or parents at this time. Please view the Registration Powerpoint and other information available on the Counseling section of the gusd.net/cvhs website for graduation requirements and post high school planning. Please discuss and draft your plan as a family but focus primarily on the 9th grade course selections for registration forms. You do not need to return the 4 year plan to CV. Counselors will review graduation progress, course selections, and post high school plans with students each year at CVHS.
- 8) **How can I audition for special programs at CV?**
Refer to the Special class auditions/Tryouts listing on the 2023-24 Registration section of the CVHS Counseling website or contact the CV teacher in charge of the desired program.
- 9) **How/when can I try out for sports at CV?**
Refer to the Athletic information on the 2023-24 Registration section of the CVHS Counseling website and attend the CVHS Sports Night on May 8th at 6pm. Contact Athletic Directors pkim@gusd.net (girls) or pschilling@gusd.net (boys) after May.
- 10) **How do I register for summer school?**
 - a) Please check the summer school section of the CVHS website <https://www.gusd.net/Page/16106>
 - b) Summer Registration forms will be posted to Google classrooms beginning Feb 14th.

- c) If students take Health in summer school, both Health AND Ethnic Studies will be dropped and replaced with a full year elective. Ethnic Studies is not a required course for graduation yet but is paired with Health during the regular school year for students who do not take Health in summer.
- d) If students take The Living Earth in summer school, they will automatically be rescheduled for Chemistry during the next school year. Students should have strong interest and skills in math and science.
- e) If students take an art elective in summer school, it will not impact their fall schedule.
- f) Students wanting to take both The Living Earth and Health will need to register for science at CV and Health at GCC-SSC.
- g) ANY non-GUSD SUMMER Programs MUST BE PRE-APPROVED by a CVHS counselor. Submit a request on the google form and your CV counselor will send an approval confirmation to you.

11) What classes should I enter for the online registration?

Students should ADD requests for the desired level of English and Math and TWO elective choices online as if summer school does not exist. Health/Ethnic Studies, Living Earth, and PE are preloaded. DO NOT load alternate choices in the computer. Only indicate alternates on the Google registration forms. CV counselors will adjust schedules after summer school enrollment is processed.

12) Can I take fewer than 7 classes? Can I take more than 7 classes?

All 9th and 10th grade students must have a full schedule of 7 classes at CV. With the addition of a 7-period schedule, 9th graders do NOT NEED to take Health in summer in order to have 2 electives. We encourage students to take a break this summer and spend the summer relaxing. Students can take additional classes with GCC dual enrollment or Jump Start but we encourage students to wait until 10th grade before adding more classes.

13) What if I have a 504 or IEP?

Your case manager will communicate any special needs to the CV case managers and counselors. Feel free to write any special notes or concerns on the Google registration form and contact the CV counselor in late May/early August.

14) When and where can I get more help?

Ask questions during the counselor presentation or individual meetings. You can also email your CV counselor.

15) How do I get involved in clubs or other activities at CV?

The CV Student Government (ASB-Associated Student Body) hosts a Club Information week in the fall. You can get a list of current clubs on the CV website (www.gusd.net/cvhs)

16) How can I get more information about specific classes or course descriptions?

Check the online GUSD course catalog or contact the teacher of the course. Consult the VAPA descriptions on website. View the CV Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathways on the website.

17) What if I am not planning to attend CVHS? Do I still need to return the registration forms?

Yes, please submit the Google registration form just in case your plans change. You may make a note in the comments section of the form with your alternative school plans. However, please make sure you notify the attendance office at Rosemont and/or CVHS regarding your new school so your records may be forwarded to the new school.

18) Can I request an individual meeting with a CVHS counselor?

CVHS Counselors will meet individually with all students in April AFTER we meet with all current 9th-11th grade CVHS students. Do your best to complete the Google registration form AND input selections in the STUDENT portal. **We encourage you to attend the Counseling Presentation on February 8th.**

THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE. We will review all course request forms and student portal entries for accuracy and make adjustments as needed prior to May 19th. If students are taking summer school, counselors will adjust course requests once summer enrollment is verified. Sports rosters will be submitted by the coaches in August and schedules will be adjusted, when possible, prior to the beginning of school.
