BFEF's Board meets the first Wednesday of every month.

Back-to-School Night: meet your child's teachers and hear about plans for the year. This evening is for adults only.

BFEF Green Team: This group meets monthly to maintain the green spaces on campus. They also support our sustainability initiatives. Set your own schedule or join our group weeding and watering sessions. We have a work weekend in May to lay down mulch before school ends.

BFEF STEAM Fair: An arts, crafts, robotics, science and DIY freefor-all on campus. This is a mashup of a Maker Faire and a Science Fair. If you've got a creative kid, this is for you!

BFEF World Fest (spring): A fun fair and fundraiser held on campus with carnival games, music, and international food.
