This year students will be allowed to "dress up" to celebrate Halloween on Tuesday, October 31st. Our monthly *Flag Assembly honoring our students of the month and recognizing students in costumes* will be held at 8:30 a.m. on the upper playground. Parents may choose to park in Lot 34 and enter through the Dads' Club gate on Canada Blvd.

*Please discuss the following rules for Halloween Costumes with your child.* We want this to be an enjoyable day for everyone.

- Students should *wear full costumes to school*. Students may not change into costumes before the assembly.
- 2. Students **MAY** change into school clothes during recess after the parade.
- 3. Students may wear facial make-up. <u>NO MASKS</u> MAY BE WORN AT SCHOOL FOR SAFETY REASONS. *Make-up needs to be applied before coming to school, not during school hours.*
- 4. Costumes must adhere to our clothing guidelines regarding modesty. Students must be appropriately covered - no bare midriffs, revealing outfits, or suggestive costumes.
- 5. **Costumes may not be gang-related** no bandannas, gang colors, etc.
- 6. **Costumes may not include any type of dangerous props.** Unfortunately, bringing anything to school that replicates a gun, knife, or weapon of any kind would mean an automatic suspension.
- 7. **No simulated blood or depiction of violence** will be permitted. These are not appropriate at school.
- 8. No Clown costumes.
