### CONTEST RULES

**Criteria for Art & Description** - Each entry must be composed of a piece of artwork **and** a description (on the entry form). **All must meet the requirements below.**

**Eligibility** - All students in **grades Kindergarten through 12th grade** who are residents of Glendale and enrolled in GUSD, private school or homeschool. *Students must work individually.*

### ARTWORK & DESCRIPTION REQUIREMENTS:

1. One entry per student
2. Artwork must be flat (2D) and able to be easily hung on a wall.
3. The entries must be no larger than 1.5' x 2.5'.
4. Any art medium may be used (e.g., colored pencils, crayons, paint); recycled materials are not required but encouraged. Artwork must be hand-drawn by the student.
5. A description of no more than 75 words must accompany the artwork (space provided on the entry form).
6. Label each entry on the back in pencil (marker bleeds through the artwork) with student's name, age, and grade, along with the teacher's name, school name, address, and telephone number.

**Entry Form** - There should be one entry form filled out per student. Please make sure that the entry form is filled out completely and legibly. All entries (entry form + artwork) must be **dropped off at Central Library between October 28-October 30.**

**Competition Process** - A panel of City employees will assess all entries and select up to 6 winners. Entries (artwork and description) will be judged on the creativity, use of recycled materials, and relevancy to the theme.
