- **Choose something that INTERESTS you!**
- In order to get extra credit, you must have a receipt from the museums that you visited or movie ticket stub (print out your online receipt) with a parent signature. **That's it!** *No Signature, No Credit*
- Each extra credit receipt makes up your worst test grade, *not including your final, a cheating incident, or a truancy grade.*
- All museums issue receipts even if you get in for free. **ASK FOR ONE!** *I will not accept anything else as credit – not even a photo out front.* Check their website before going.
- Use your CVHS student ID card for possible discounts.
- *If you will be visiting a historic site outside of Southern California, please let me know before you go in order that you can possibly substitute it for one of the museums above.*
- **YES**, even if you have been there before, you must go during this time frame to earn credit.
- All extra credit is **due by Monday, Dec. 11, 2023** by the end of your class period – no exceptions!! *You may turn it in at any time prior to this date.*

**Choose 2 of the following 10 to do:**

1. Visit the **Autry Museum of the American West** – Griffith Park (*Westward Movement*)
  - ❖ [theautry.org](http://theautry.org)
    - **Students with ID:** \$12.00 admission
    - Open Tuesday through Sunday, 9/10 am to 4:00/5:00 p.m. Free to the public on the second Tuesday of every month. Closed on Mondays.
2. Visit the **California African American Museum (CAAM)** – Exposition Park (*African American culture & history*)
  - [caamuseum.org](http://caamuseum.org)
  - **Admission:** Free. Parking at the CA Science Center is \$15. This can be your receipt.
  - *Be aware of Saturday USC games, LAFC, & Angel City games in your planning.*
  - Open Tuesday-Sunday, 10 am-5 pm
3. Visit the **Chinese American Museum (CAM)** – Los Angeles – south from Olvera Street. (*Chinese Immigration*)
  - ❖ [camla.org](http://camla.org)
    - **Child (4-17):** \$2.00 admission.
    - Open Tuesday to Sunday - 10 am to 3 pm
4. Visit the **Peterson Automotive Museum** – Los Angeles – across from LACMA (*Car culture*)
  - ❖ [petersen.org](http://petersen.org)
    - **Child (4-17):** \$12.95 admission.
    - Open Daily - 10 am to 6 pm
5. Visit **Will Rogers State Park** – Pacific Palisades (*Roaring 20s & Great Depression*)
  - ❖ [parks.ca.gov/?page\\_id=626](http://parks.ca.gov/?page_id=626)
    - **Parking: \$12** – This will be your receipt.
    - Tour the home of the Vaudeville star and humorist – check website for times
    - Open daily

6. Visit the **Museum of Tolerance** at the Simon Wiesenthal Center– West L.A. (*WWII/Holocaust*)
- ❖ [museumoftolerance.com](http://museumoftolerance.com)
    - **Students with ID:** \$12.00 admission.
    - The museum is open on Thursday, Friday, & Sunday. It is closed on Saturdays in observance of the Jewish Sabbath and for Jewish holidays (i.e. Yom Kippur). **Purchase tickets online for a reserved time to assure your visit.** Free parking is available located underneath the museum.
7. Visit the **Academy Museum of Motion Pictures** – Los Angeles – next door to LACMA (*Movie culture & history*)

    - **Child (4-17):** Free
    - Open Sun.-Thurs. 10 am to 6 pm, Fri. – Sat. 10 am to 8 pm
8. Visit the **Southern California Railway Museum (SCRM)** in Perris, CA in Riverside County (*Railroad/LA Public Transportation history*)
- ❖ [socalrailway.org](http://socalrailway.org)
    - **Adult Admission - \$12, Kids (5-11) - \$8**
    - Open Daily
    - Trains & Streetcars (included in admission) run only on Weekends
    - This is a great family trip especially if you have fathers or grandfathers who love trains!
9. Eat at **Philippe the Original** – Downtown L.A. - across from Union Station (*Los Angeles history*)
- ❖ [philippes.com](http://philippes.com)
    - **Eat at least one FRENCH DIP SANDWICH - \$11.50**
    - Philippe's is LA HISTORY. It is where the French Dip sandwich began.
    - YOU must ask for a receipt when you pay. Don't forget it!
    - Open DAILY from 6 am-10 pm.
    - *This is not a good choice trip for vegetarians. ☺*

10. Go to a movie theater and watch **ONE** of these:

**Golda** (opens Aug. 25) – PG13 (*Prime Minister of Israel; Yom Kippur War*)

OR

**Dumb Money** (opens Sept. 22) – Not Rated as of 8/14 (*GameStop Stock*)

OR

**Killers of the Flower Moon** (opens Oct. 20) – R (*1920s, Osage Tribe*)

OR

**Napoleon** (opens Nov. 22) – R (*Reign/Biography of Napoleon*)

- ❖ Turn in your ticket stub OR online purchase **receipt printout** by your parent
- ❖ You may only go and watch **ONE** movie **in a movie theater** for CREDIT. **Downloads, VOD, and rentals don't count.** *You need to get out of the house!*
