I. Objectives

The student will:

- A. Gain an understanding of how to help the teacher in the classroom.
- B. Increase his knowledge by preparing to teach others.
- C. Gain an understanding of the problems in a classroom.
- D. Be helped to determine if teaching might be his occupational choice.

II. Outline of Content

The student will:

- A. Give general assistance to the teacher in the classroom.
- B. Help other students by working with individuals and small groups.
- C. Teach the whole class lessons prepared by the student aide under the direction of the classroom teacher.
- D. Help the teacher in grading, correcting of papers, keeping roll, and making materials for the classroom.
- E. Present special abilities or talents to the classroom.
- F. Give a substitute assistance with the class when the regular teacher is absent.

III. Minimum Requirements

- A. Show a good relationship with the students and the teacher.
- B. Do projects assigned by the supervising teacher as designated.
- C. Show a willingness to follow and carry out instructions of the teacher.
- D. Have a satisfactory attendance record.
