Jump Start VS. Dual Enrollment

Jump Start

- College courses taken on a college campus
- Credit will only be applied to the college transcript
- Will help students earn units towards university transfer (IGETC)
- Free of charge for high school students

Dual Enrollment

- College courses typically offered on a high school campus
- Credit will be applied to the college and high school transcripts if courses are taken in the fall and spring semesters
- Provides a boost to the high school GPA if the course is taken in fall and spring and applied to the transcript
- Will help students earn units towards university transfer (IGETC)
- Free of charge for high school students

Registration Dates

- Fall 2020-Deadline to enroll is September 25, 2020
- Winter 2021-Enrollment begins November 10, 2020
- Spring 2021-Enrollment begins December 14, 2020

Applying to GCC

1. Go to [Apply to GCC | Glendale Community College](#)
2. Click on Create an Account
3. After you create your account, save your OpenCCC account information for later use
4. Start GCC Application
5. Complete all required sections until green check marks appear for each section
6. Submit your application
7. Once you submit your application you will see a confirmation page. Write down your confirmation number, but note that it is not your GCC ID #.
8. You will receive an email from GCC within 24-72 hours with your Student ID number.

A Few Things to Keep in Mind

- Counselors must approve all Dual Enrollment or Jump Start courses.
- Counselors have discretion over which courses they will allow you to take.
- Counselors will review your grades before approving any GCC classes. If you are not maintaining your grades, you will not be approved to take a GCC class until your grades have improved.
- We ask that you not email your counselor to see if she has received your GCC DocuSign application or inquire about when she will sign it. If you have done your part correctly, we will receive your application and sign it at our earliest convenience.
- Allow 72 hours for processing after submitting your application. You may review the status of your application at <https://mygcc.glendale.edu/psmygcc/login.asp>
- Please do not email your counselor asking if you were enrolled in the GCC class as we do not have that information.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **How many GCC classes can I take?**
 - You can take up to two GCC classes each semester with counselor approval.
- **Can I take a Jump Start and Dual Enrollment Course at the same time?**
 - Yes, you can take one Jump Start class and one Dual Enrollment class simultaneously.
- **Can I take any core academic classes at GCC?**
 - No, you may not take math, English, science or history classes at GCC.
- **Can I take GCC classes that are during the day on school days?**
 - No, you cannot take any GCC classes between the hours of 8am-3pm on weekdays because they'll conflict with your Clark classes.
- **Does my counselor need to approve my GCC classes?**
 - Yes, your counselor must approve any GCC classes you wish to take.

- **Do I have to take a GCC class?**
 - It is not mandatory to take a GCC class. When considering whether you should, think about your Clark course load and whether adding a college class would be manageable for you.
