

General Playground Rules

<p>Redirection for safety reasons Student that does not comply after redirection will receive blue slip.</p>	<p><u>School Safety Rules</u> Consequence blue-slip</p>
<p>Running through games <i>Reason:</i> Student may be hit by game play <i>Redirection:</i> to track or grass area</p>	<p>Bullying Behavior: Verbal - name calling, teasing, etc. Nonverbal - staring, threatening gesture, etc. Emotional - excluding, humiliating, etc. <i>(See Bullying Prevention Information Package for full definition and list of Bullying Behavior)</i></p>
<p>Laying down on asphalt area <i>Reason:</i> Student may be stepped on and it is difficult for yard staff to identify injured students <i>Redirection:</i> to grass area by Book and Game</p>	<p>Chase is not allowed</p> <hr/> <p>Playing on non-play equipment is not allowed such as climbing fences, hanging from handrails or doing gymnastics.</p>
<p>Balls should not be kicked - only exception football and soccer are on the grass. <i>Reason:</i> Safety <i>Redirection:</i> to grass area games</p>	<p>Students are not permitted to throw objects.</p> <hr/> <p>Students must keep hands and feet to self.</p>
<p>Inside voices and behavior in lunch areas <i>Reason:</i> Safety <i>Redirection:</i> asked to use quiet voices</p>	<p>Students must check in with adult prior to going to restroom. There is no playing in the restrooms.</p>
<p>Play Structure Equipment Safety Rules</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One person at a time on the ladder/slide • Students go down the fireman’s pole • Students may not jump off of the equipment • Students go down the slides on their “bottoms”, feet first • No hanging upside down on the equipment • Feet stay on the equipment floor. Heads should always stay higher than feet • Horizontal bars should not be used for swinging. • No running / chasing on the play structure. <p><i>Reason:</i> Safety <i>Redirection:</i> reminded of rules</p>	<p>Students may not go into restricted areas as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The grass area outside the Kindergarten classrooms. • Behind buildings • Classrooms are restricted during recess due to lack of supervision <hr/> <p>Students may not run, stand, play, or get a drink of water after the bell. Students are required to “freeze” & “sit” when the bell rings, then WALK to their lines when the whistle blows. Students have access to drinking water throughout recess & with room teacher permission after recess.</p>
<p>During California’s infrequent rainy days, students are kept inside. If there is a break in the rain, but the playground is significantly wet, the students will be permitted to go out and get fresh air but for safety reasons will not do regular playground activities.</p>
