

Class Info

<u>Portal (for grades) / Google Classroom (for assignments):</u> All parents and students should have access to the portal. You will be checking the history grades here throughout the year. Grades will NOT be kept in Google Classroom. Google Classroom is a place for students to receive and turn in digital assignments. Paper assignments will be passed out in class and may not be posted in Google Classroom.

<u>Class Work:</u> Acceptable work must be show effort and evidence of following the directions. Students should use correct grammar, spelling, and punctuation. Class work not meeting the criteria in the directions may not be accepted or may receive a lowered grade. Blank work will lower your citizenships grade and all blank answers will count as zero points with NO make-up opportunity.

<u>Plagiarism:</u> Students may not copy and paste answers from the internet. If students do this, they may earn a zero. Students are expected to read the materials presented in class and submit answers from the teachers' materials.

<u>Late Work/ Closed Weeks</u>: Work turned in after the due date is LATE and will receive ½ credit. Late work may not be turned in after the week is CLOSED.

<u>Absences / Make Up Work:</u> Students with an excused absence can complete any work that is posted in Google Classroom before the due date. If the student has a lengthy absence or if they need more time to complete an assignment, they should email the teacher for directions.



Email etiquette:

- □ For all emails please write: Student's full name and period in the email. Please be aware that I have over 150 students. Writing the full name and class period will help me to answer your email in a timely manner.
- ☐ Are you at school and have a question? Students should avoid emailing the teacher during the school day while you are in other classes. If you are at school, please come to the room during snack, lunch, after school, or after class and ask your questions in person.
- Are you at home with a question? If you are at HOME and have a question, please check the portal and Google Classroom first. After that, you may email the teacher with your questions from home.
- □ When will the teacher write back? I will write back promptly during school hours. If it is a weekend, I will write back during the following school day. Sometimes, I do receive many emails about the same topic. If this occurs, I may send a group email response.

<u>Class procedures:</u> Class procedures will be discussed as needed. Students are expected to learn the procedures. If there is no attempt to follow class procedures, this will affect your citizenship grade, you may be kept after class, you may have a parent conference, or you may receive a referral which will go on your permanent school record.
