- 1 year Visual and Performing Art

 - *All A-G courses must be completed a C grade or higher



Planning Notes: English

- English Options:
 - 9th Grade English 9 or English 9 Advance
 - Students must have earned an A or B in the previous English class in order to be place in English 9 Advance
- If you are an ELD student, you will select English 9 and your ELD Support class will be added by your counselor.
- You will have 2 periods of English daily


•Counselors will confirm your English choice before you are placed in the class.



Planning Notes: Math

- Math Progression:
- Integrated Math IA -B
- Integrated Math IIA B
 or
- Integrated Math II/IIIA-B Accelerated (must meet all requirements)
- If you are currently in Math 8 select Integrated Math I
- If you are currently in Integrated Math I and passing with A or B you can choose Integrated II.
- If you are earning a C or lower we recommend you retake Integrated I in 9th grade.

Planning Notes: Science



Select your science class

- All 9th grade students must select Living Earth
- You have the option of taking Living Earth in the summer for acceleration if you will be in Integrated II or higher next year. Once you complete this class you will be enrolled in Chemistry of the Earth System.

Social Studies + Health

- History Options + Health:
 - 1 semester of Human Geography + 1 semester of Health or
 - AP Human Geography
 - · Health must be completed in summer if you are interested in taking AP Human Geography
 - If you want to take an AP course, you must have A's/B's in this year's English class.
- You can also choose to take Health in the summer for acceleration and add an additional elective to your schedule.

Physical Education

PE Courses Available:

- PE 9 1-2
- Marching Band
- Beginning Dance (subject to availability)

Sports

- Select PE 9 even if you hope to play for a team!
- You must tryout for any sports team.
- If you make the team, you will be added to the team by your counselor, and removed from PE.

Academic Elective Options

- Foreign Language
- To enroll in a foreign language students must earn a "C" or better in 8th grade English
- If you are part of a FLAG program add foreign language to your selection.
- Visual and Performing Art
 - •One year required to meet a-g college requirements AND high school graduation requirements!
 - Be cautious when selecting your VAPA course because some courses are not A-G. Check all of our courses offered on the GHS Elective Course Listing for accurate selection.





- ✓ Complete the Google Doc to indicate your course selections. Once completed you can enter your course requests in Student Connect (Q)






Q Registration Step 2: "Switch Track" & "Requests"

IMPORTANT NOTE: Before clicking on requests, choose the new school year of the grade you will be in next year.




Q Registration Step 3: "Add/Edit Requests






Q Registration Step 4: "Add Selected Class", and click SUBMIT




Q Registration Step 7: When done adding classes, click "Sign Out"
