



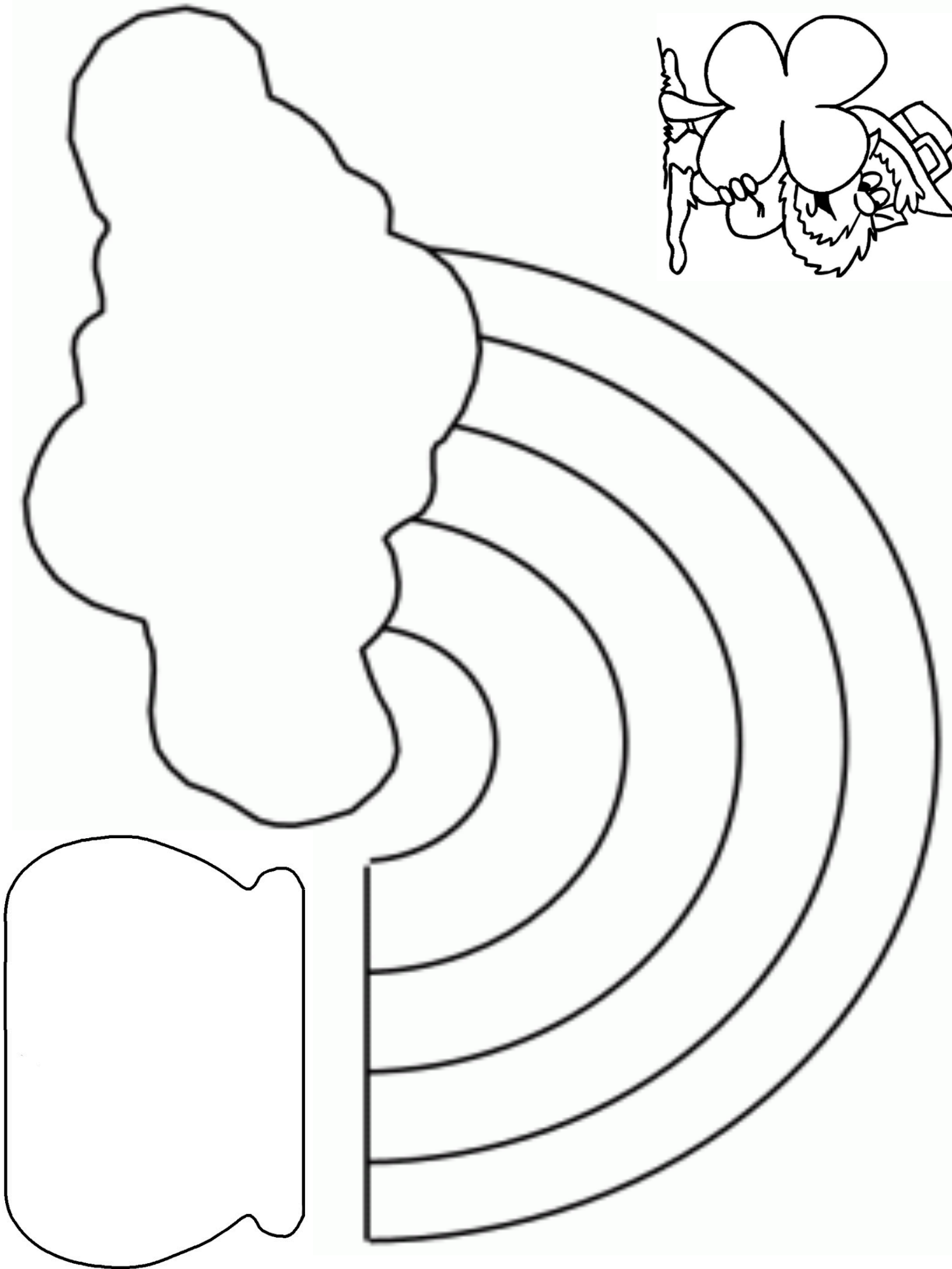
March Family Project
