Please return this project anytime before the end of the month. Please write everyone's name on the back that worked on the project for all attached sheets.

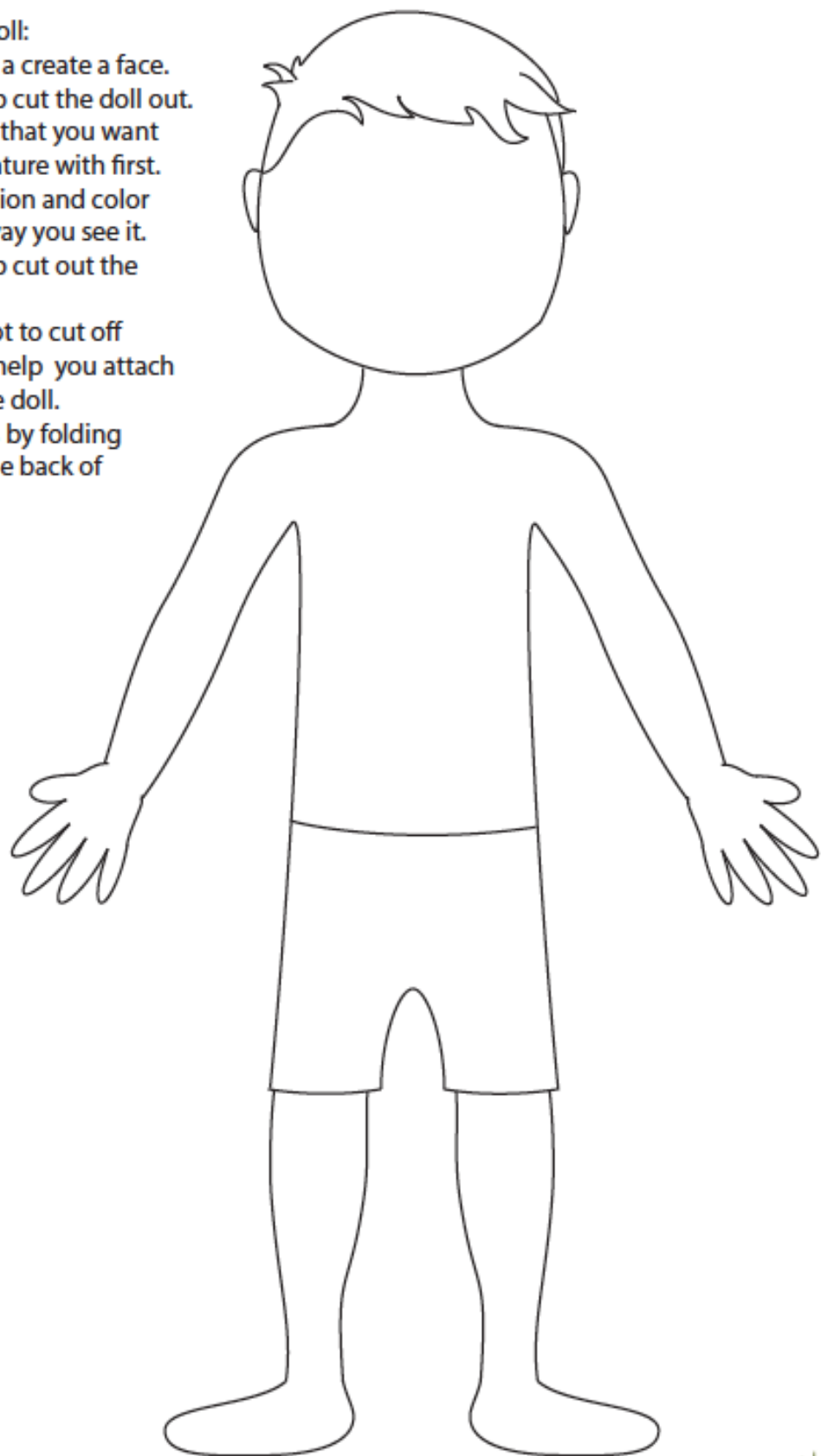
