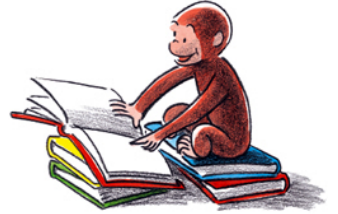


# Weekly Extended Learning Opportunity
