About This School

Thomas Jefferson Elementary's Academic Performance Index (API) is 881. Jefferson School's growth has been in a positive trend for most all of the previous nine years. Despite a high Socio-Economic Disadvantaged population (as measured by Free and reduced lunches, 75%), and a higher percentage of English Language learners (ELL's 65%), our school continues to do well on the California Standards Tests (CST), earning a ranking in the top ten percent in the state for similar schools ranking. As well, our Academic Performance Index is in the top ten percent of achievement. In comparison, Thomas Jefferson performs well above the state average. Our school is also home to the Armenian Heritage and Dual Language Academy program, which is a part of the Glendale District's Foreign Language Academies. Our Academy teaches a second language (Armenian) literacy curriculum in addition to the district's core curriculum. At Thomas Jefferson School, we also have GATE (Gifted and Talented Education) students who participate in the Invention Convention and Math Field Day contest. The warm and welcoming principal is readily available to meet with parents to share and discuss any concerns parents may have or get additional information about our school. Parent trainings or workshops are scheduled throughout the year, affording parents opportunities to increase their knowledge about the school's academic expectations and to learn skills to help support their children to do well in school. Also, our very active and involved Jefferson PTA plays a vital role in the success of the school with volunteering opportunities for parents, providing various assemblies provided for students. The newly established Jefferson Elementary School Foundation (JESF) is on its way to becoming a great fun raising group to support the school provide learning opportunities for all Jefferson Students.
