The following questions were part of a survey conducted, both online and over the telephone, May 8, 2014 through May 18, 2014.

Of the one thousand six hundred four (1,604) registered voters contacted, six hundred ninety-five (695) took part in the survey. This is a 43% response rate, which is exceptionally high.
