# GUSD Plan to Maintain District Solvency and Financial Responsibility

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## Preview of 2019-20 Governor's May Revision

### ➤ Proposition 98 Minimum Guarantee

- 2018-19 – up by \$278.8 million from the Governor's Budget for an estimated \$78.1 billion – The impact of this increase is approximately \$43 per ADA – More details after the May Revision
- 2019-20 – up by \$389.3 million from the Governor's Budget for a proposed guarantee of \$81.1 billion and \$3 billion year over year – The impact of this increase is approximately \$60 per ADA – More details after the May Revision

### ➤ Cost-of-Living Adjustment

- 2019-20 COLA – Decreased from 3.46% to 3.26% - The impact of this is a decrease of approximately \$250,000 in LCFF Base – More details after the May Revision



## Preview of 2019-20 Governor's May Revision – Cont.

### ➤ Special Education


- Slight increase to the January proposal to support school readiness of districts with high percentages of student with disabilities and unduplicated students

### ➤ CalSTRS Relief

- Slight increase for one-time funding to reduce employer contribution rate. Added \$150 million for a total of \$3.15 billion – STRS rate will increase from 16.28% (2018-19) to 16.7% (2019-20) – The impact of this is a savings of approximately \$490,000 compared to January Proposal – More details after the May Revision



## Cautions and Challenges

- Future Funding - Unstable COLA%, Unduplicated Pupil Percentage, and Enrollment 
- Special Education - Program Needs Increasing
- Projected Negative Unrestricted General Fund Adjusted Balances in future if budget reductions are not made
- Additional Funding to Cover CalPERS and CalSTRS Increases is proposed only.
- Financial Stability Plan for 2019-20 of \$5.0 m, and for 2020-21 will likely be at least \$5.0 m
- Impact of 2018-19 Negotiations – Already committed the 2018-19 LCFF increase to the previous wage increase – Can't spend the same increase twice
- Sagebrush Transfer
