SUBJECT: Enrollment Information for 2018-19 (as of October 3, 2018)

The District has concluded the CALPADS enrollment report for 2018-19, reflecting enrollment at 25,790. This is a decrease of 281 students over the number on last year's report and was 420 less than projected.

The Historical Enrollment graph attached indicates that grades TK-6 decreased 40 students over the prior year, grades 7-8 decreased 114 students, and grades 9-12 decreased 127 students, resulting in a total decrease of 281 students for all grades. The large decrease in students breaks the improving trend experienced from the prior four years. Attached is a detailed report of the current enrollment and related history.

The District has been very active in developing/maintaining programs that attract and retain students including FLAG, Magnet Programs, and Career Tech Programs. A subsequent information report will be prepared to discuss new strategies to increase enrollment.

# **Enrollment Information for 2018-19**

The first attachment provides information regarding regular and special education enrollment for all elementary and secondary schools. The information includes:

- Actual enrollment for 2017-18 (as of CALPADS)
- Projected enrollment for 2018-19 (used in Budget development)

- The percentage change between the two report dates

Enrollment for 2018-19 (as of CALPADS) was 25,790. The District's total enrollment has decreased approximately -1.08% (-281 students) from 2017-18 CALPADS.

The second attachment provides information used in 2018-19 Budget development, and outlines both the Standard Progression and historical trend projections. Below is a comparison of the two projection methods to the actual enrollment as of CALPADS.


