

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON INTENTION OF GLENDALE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
TO CONSIDER ENTERING INTO AN ENERGY SERVICE CONTRACT
AND FACILITY FINANCING AND LEASE AGREEMENTS**


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the intention of the Governing Board of the Glendale Unified School District (“District”) to consider entering into an energy service contract pursuant to the terms of Government Code section 4217.12 and facility financing contracts in the form of a site lease and lease agreement pursuant to the terms of Government Code sections 4217.13, both in connection with the financing, design and construction of certain energy conservation facilities (the “Equipment”) at various school campus locations throughout the District (“Agreements”).

The Board will consider facts and testimony to determine whether the Agreements are in the best interests of the District and whether the anticipated cost of the thermal, electrical, or other energy that would have been consumed under the Agreements will be less than the anticipated cost of the thermal, electrical, or other energy that would have been consumed without the Agreements.

The time and place set for the public hearing on the intention of the Governing Board of the District to consider entering into the Agreements is **October 4, 2016, beginning at 6:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the District’s **Administration Center located at 223 North Jackson Street, Glendale, CA, 91206.**

At such time, the testimony of all interested persons for or against the proposed Agreements will be heard. Any protest pertaining to the regularity or sufficiency of the proceedings shall be in writing, and shall clearly set forth the irregularities and defects to which the objection is made. Any written protest shall be filed with the Board Secretary of the District on or before the time set for the hearing. The District may waive any irregularities in the form or content of any written notice and at the hearing may correct minor defects in the proceedings. Written protests may be withdrawn, in writing, at any time before the conclusion of the hearing.
